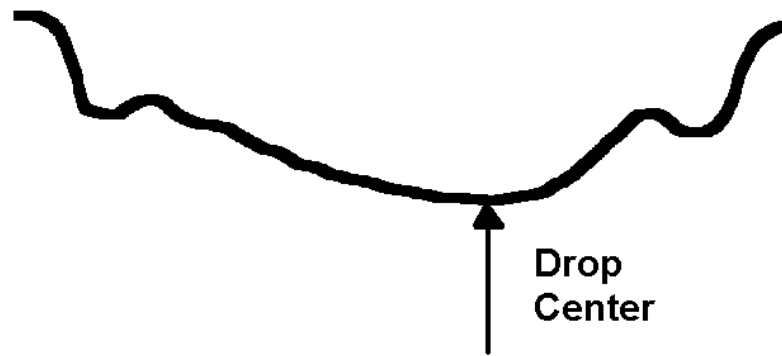




Ordering Procedure

- I. All orders should be sent to us as a purchase order on company letterhead. A purchase order number should be affixed to this document.
- II. This document should contain the following information about the vehicle that the runflats are being made for. This is to properly identify the rim.
 - a. Make, model, and the year that this vehicle was produced. If the rim is a custom wheel, please include the name of the manufacturer (Example: American Racing Equipment). This is the initial identification to insure the correct profile of the wheel.
 - b. The actual wheel size, for example **16x7J**. This can be located somewhere on the rim.
 - c. The drop center circumference of the wheel. This is the circular measurement at the lowest point of the rim (see diagram). It can be measured in either centimeters or inches with a tape measure.





- d. The wheel identification. Each manufacturer provides an ID number inside of the wheel. For example: some common Chevrolet Suburbans use an ID number of 9592561; some common Ford Expeditions use an ID number of YL34-1015-CA; some common Jeep Grand Cherokees use an ID number of 5EZ98TRMAB.
- III. If some or all of these criteria cannot be met, please send one of the wheels to our location for profiling. Please send the exact wheel that you wish to have the runflats mounted to. If you have alloy wheels on the vehicle and a steel spare rim, they may not have the same profile. Please also include a copy of the supplied **Wheel Consignment Form** with the shipment.
- IV. Please also provide the tire size (Example: P255/65 R16), that we may check the clearance of the runflat. After this is accomplished, we will send the results of this check prior to entering the order. This will allow you to choose the correct runflats.
- V. After all of these steps are taken, we will enter the order and a written confirmation will be sent to you. Please review this confirmation.
